



AVOID BLIND SPOTS

We have all seen cars ride for miles in a truck's blind spot when it would be quite easy for them to either speed up and be seen, or drop back out of harm's way. Sooner or later that truck driver is going to want to change lanes, and the longer you drive in a blind spot, the more of a hazard you create for yourself and the truck.

Blind spot crashes have been found to occur almost twice as often as other crashes with trucks. And blind-spot crashes can be almost totally eliminated by the application of a little common sense. *Do not stay in the blind spot any longer than totally necessary!*
