## PALM CARDS

## GIVEAWAYS

Hand these out during seat belt checks or other community events

## INSTRUCTOR RESOURCES

Share safety recall messages with participants of driver education courses

## TALKING POINTS

Incorporate Check To Protect messages into presentations or other meetings

## POSTERS

Display these in common rooms at the station as a campaign reminder



## MAGNETS

Hand these out to remind drivers to check their VIN every 3 months for recalls
